

## MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT) POLICY AND PROCEDURE

MAT as defined by SAMHSA includes opioid treatment programs (OTP) and combines behavioral therapy and medications to treat substance use disorders.

- Individuals coming into McShin that are currently on MAT must follow McShin's medication monitoring policy and are subject to all additional rules and regulations.
  - o Individuals showing effects of being overly medicated, will be required to have consultation with an addiction specialist to adjust the dosage.
  - o If individuals abuse MAT, they will be subject to a Recovery Plan Assessment.
- Individuals who are currently at McShin and request MAT must go through an Addiction Specialist.
- As of 9/01/2022 Medical Cannabis is not an acceptable form of MAT at McShin.
- All financial expenses for consultation, prescription, and transportation to appointments regarding MAT are the responsibility of the participant, unless otherwise approved by Mcshin staff.

## KRATOM POLICY AND PROCEDURE

Although Kratom is considered a natural remedy, it can produce illicit effects. Since there is no way to monitor how an individual is taking Kratom, McShin has implementing a zero-tolerance policy. Therefore, any participant who tests positive for Kratom will be treated as if they were positive for any mood- or mind-altering chemical.
